

DocBike Dorset Ride Out

Sunday 25th September 2022

Event Terms and Conditions



The terms and conditions detailed below apply to all riders participating in DocBike Dorset's Ride Out:

- The event terms and conditions
- To have read and abide by the event safety "Safety Advice Issued to Riders" document, which will have been sent to you following your registration online.
- To follow the instruction of the safety brief, marshals and volunteers
- To conduct yourself on the day in a manner that reflects motorcyclists and the DocBike charity in a positive light

A copy of these terms and conditions and the "**safety advice to riders**" document will be available to read at the start of the event for those signing up on the day.

1) Entry

- a) By registering for the ride out, participants are automatically entered for free into the event grand raffle.
- b) The raffle will be drawn on Sunday 25th September at Henstridge Airfield. Participants do not need to be present in order to win and winners will be contacted following the event to arrange delivery/collection of their prize/s.
- c) Additional tickets can be purchased on the day of the event. You do not need to take part on the ride out to enter the raffle, raffle tickets can be purchased by those attending the event.
- d) Completion of a registration form and payment of entry fees, either online or on the day in person, acknowledges acceptance of the terms and conditions.
- e) Places are non-transferrable. We are a charity and hope that supporters appreciate that refunds will not be given or places will not be deferred in the event of non-attendance.
- f) Payment of the entry fee does not include any insurance protection for accident, sickness, or negligence of any individual participant. Any accident or injury caused by the participant's actions will be the full responsibility of said participant.

2) The Event

- a) This event is non-competitive, and times will not be recorded.

- b) Participants can register to take part in one of two routes; West Bay Esplanade to Henstridge Airfield or The Churchill Arms in Alderholt to Henstridge Airfield.
- c) Participants are to arrive at the start location of their chosen route no earlier than 8.30am and must sign in by 10.00am.
- d) Before the ride out commences, all participants will be providing with an event briefing.
- e) The ride out will commence at 10.30am from each start location and both routes will finish at Henstridge Airfield. The event will close at 4.00pm.
- f) Onsite parking will be provided at the end point of the ride out (Henstridge Airfield) free of charge, however DocBike cannot accept any responsibility for any damage or loss which may occur whilst using this facility.

3) Conduct of Participants

- a) All participants agree to abide, and follow the advice, direction, and instruction of DocBike event officials to ensure a safe and successful event.
- b) We ask that all participants and supporters behave in a respectful manner to organisers, marshals and other participants, such that they, motorcycling and the DocBike charity are represented in a positive light.
- c) Behaving in a way which may cause injury or harm to other participants and/or supporters or which may cause offence or damage to the reputation of DocBike will not be tolerated and such participants will be asked to leave and not be permitted to take part in future events.

4) Health and Safety

- a) DocBike takes rider safety very seriously and has gone to lengths to ensure that risks from this ride are minimised. DocBike will not be responsible for harm caused by irresponsible rider behaviour and the charity asks riders to embody a culture of respect and safe riding during the event and generally.
- b) Participants are fully responsible for their actions whilst attending the event. This includes before, during and after the ride out itself. DocBike does not accept responsibility for the actions of participants nor the consequences of any such actions.
- c) Participants **MUST** adhere to current government and DocBike COVID guidelines at all times. If any specific precautions are required, you will be notified about this by email before the event.

- d) Each participant will be fully responsible for any fees or costs incurred or arising from an accident either involving or caused by the participant. If the situation arises that you are not capable of making the decision to call the emergency services, the Participant agrees that the organisers or a member of the public may call them. In this situation, the participant still accepts the costs and consequences of such action.
- e) Each participant, upon completing the registration process, agrees that they are physically and mentally capable of taking part. If there is any doubt, the participant should consult their GP.
- f) Participants may be refused the right of participation in the ride out, where the organiser believes the participant's safety and/or the safety of others, may be compromised.
- g) Participants must not put themselves at unnecessary risk when undertaking the event and should follow the route given. UK road law should be followed at all times.

5) Cancellation

- a) Should the Dorset Ride Out be cancelled or delayed due to unforeseen circumstances, DocBike will endeavour to stage the event at a later date. In such a case, DocBike will endeavour to advise participants in writing, where possible. DocBike's liability in respect of costs and expenses which participants may incur as a result of such cancellation or delay will amount to the sum paid for entry into the event only.
- b) Should The Dorset Ride Out be cancelled, refunds will be issued upon application up to, and including, Monday 3rd October 2022. Applications can be made by emailing: info@docbike.org

6) Miscellaneous

- a) Participants agree that images taken during the event may be used by DocBike to promote the work of the charity and for advertising of future events.

7) Sponsorship

8) Use of Your Information

- a) When you register for the ride out, we collect personal data relating to you and anyone else that you register. This information will be used for the purposes of organising, administering and staging the event.
- b) DocBike will never share your details outside of our organisation without asking you first. Occasionally, we would very much like to be able to contact you when our research team are looking for people to be involved in questionnaires (advancing our research into keeping bikers alive) and to let you know about significant charity events or news that we think you would like to know about. As an organisation we do not believe in the constant messaging that some organisations undertake and promise not to message you frequently; but if you would rather we didn't ever contact you, please email us at data.protection@docbike.org.
